5.1 Approve the Amended Administration of Fire Services Agreement with the Branciforte Fire Protection

District and Authorize the Board President to Sign on Behalf of the SVFPD, Discussion/Action

Chief Kovacs reported that the track changes copy of the Administration of Fire Services Agreement (Agreement) was included in the Board Packet. The amended Agreement is effective July 1, 2019 and the annual cost of \$105,727 will be invoiced over 12 monthly payments. The Agreement identifies the process for the Branciforte Fire Protection District (BFPD) to hire a Battalion Chief and through training, eventually take over the duties the SVFPD has been providing. After the BFPD Board approves the agreement next week, a timeline will be established for the transition process.
